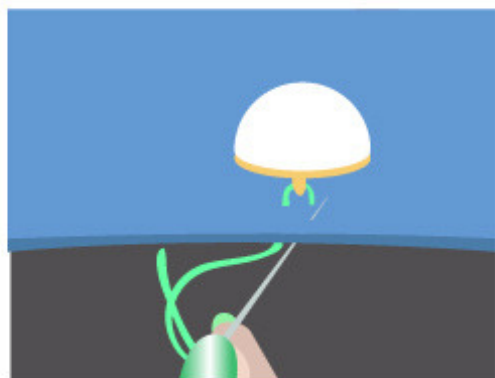
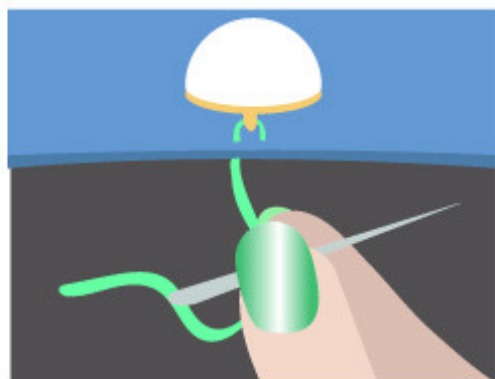


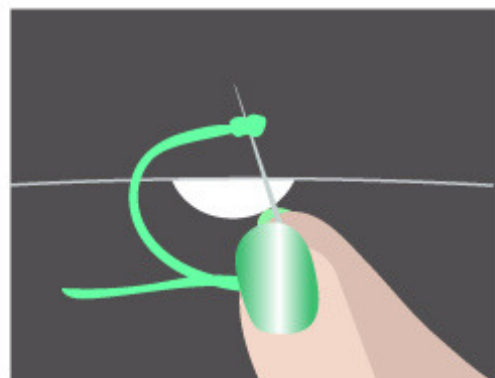
HOW TO SEW A ONE HOLE BUTTON



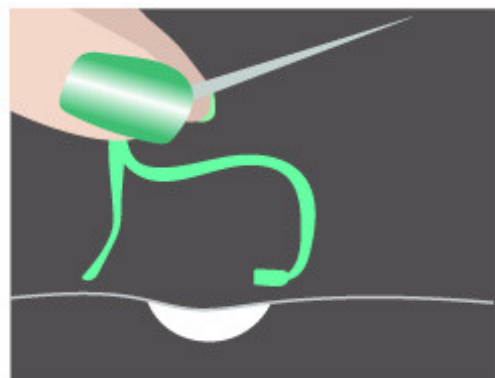
1. Thread your needle and knot the end. Push the needle and thread through the loop of the button and push down through to the other side and to the back of the fabric.



2. Repeat the process of pushing the needle and thread up through the fabric, across the button loop and to the back of the fabric several times.



3. On the wrong side, push the needle and thread through the existing stitches to secure. You can also make a thread shank to secure the button.



4. To finish: Remove the needle and tie off the thread. Then cut off the excess.
