## Profile B: The Modern Minimalist

→ Simple slip dress in bias-cut silk	→ French seams
→ A quality tote bag	→ Grading between sizes

DREAM FABRICS: Ponte knit, organic linen, wool crepe, chambray, tencel, Nani Iro solids

COLOR PALETTE: Off-white, oatmeal, charcoal, slate, pale gray, black, warm white

## Profile C: The Boho Maker

Creative, fearless, and wonderfully you — you use fabric as a canvas. You're not afraid of color, pattern mixing, or making something completely one-of-a-kind. Your sewing space looks like an art studio, and your finished pieces spark conversation wherever you go.

→ Patchwork kimono jackets	→ Raw edge appliqué
→ A statement maxi skirt with tiers	→ Color blocking
→ Upcycled denim with appliqué	→ Upcycling and reconstruction
→ Colorblock wrap top	→ Surface design (dyeing, painting)
→ Hand-painted canvas tote	→ Free-motion embroidery

DREAM FABRICS: Velvet, batik, African wax prints, denim, jacquard, hand-dyed fabric, upcycled materials

COLOR PALETTE: Deep teal, terracotta, burnt orange, jewel purple, forest green, unexpected combos

## Profile D: Classic Elegance

Timeless, refined, and built to last — you sew with purpose. You're drawn to classic silhouettes, quality fabrics, and techniques that stand the test of time. Your wardrobe is curated, not chaotic, and every piece you sew is made to be treasured for years.
